Dear Parents,

You have a kill-two-birds-with-one-stone field trip permission form in your hands. I'm trying to make things easier on you!

The first trip is next Tuesday, December 15. Our class will be heading to Erickson Woods (part of the Skokie Lagoons) for the first Mighty Acorns field trip of the year. (This is the one that was rescheduled from November.) Your child will need to wear appropriate outdoor gear, including gloves, hats, boots (waterproof hopefully) and snow pants. The wrinkle is that you will need to PICK UP YOUR CHILD at the Lagoons. Pick-up will be around 2:50 p.m. (This is due to a bus issue with the district.) We will pick up at the back of the parking lot attached to the woods, located off of Willow Road, just east of the 94 overpass.

The second trip will be the 4th grade holiday bowling party on Friday, December 18. We will head to the Wilmette Bowl (on Schiller, just south of Ridge Rd and Lake in Wilmette) around 12:45. The party ends at 2:45 p.m. and you are requested to pick up your child AT THE BOWLING ALLEY.

If you are not able to pick your child up from one (or both) of the field trips, please arrange with another parent for your child to be picked up.

The cost for the bowling trip will be covered by Hubbard Woods School – there is no need to send money. Parents are welcome to join us at both events! (It is my understanding that room parents will be coordinating some snacks and drinks.)
