# Flash Card Time

Your job tonight is to spend about 15 or 20 minutes working with your multiplication flash cards. Here's what I'd like you to do:

- Begin quizzing yourself.
- As you answer the facts, start making two piles:
  - PILE ONE: The facts you *really* know and can answer in a flash. (That's why they're called *flash* cards.) Let's say three seconds or less is a flash.
  - PILE TWO: The facts you don't know or don't know quickly.
- After you've gone through the whole set of cards once, spend some time on PILE TWO.
  - If you have a lot of cards in Pile Two, separate them into smaller groups to make it easier to practice.
  - If you have just a few cards in Pile Two, spend some time learning them and getting faster at knowing them.
- If you don't have a PILE TWO, and all of your multiplication facts are *flashy*, then I think you should pull out your division flash cards and get *flashy* with them!
