Dear Parents,

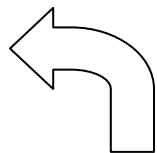
As part of our continuing unit on the Maya civilization, we will be building a Mayan village in class, using sugar cubes. The students will be working on a temple, castle, plaza, or other building and we will put the finished products together to create a Maya village.

I am asking for each student to bring in **FOUR** boxes of sugar cubes. The best kind is Domino brand, in the 1 lb. yellow box. Also good is the C&H brand in the smallish red/pink and white box (about 5" x 8"). If possible, please try to locate these types. If you are not able to find the Domino or C&H, please at least make sure that the box ***does NOT say*** "rough cut." Rough cut cubes are of uneven shapes and sizes and are much tougher to use.

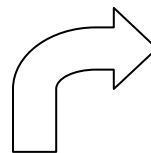
